# How to Make a Field Trip Reservation

There are 4 easy ways to make a reservation:

#### **Helpful Hints for Booking**

Please prepare the following information to make the reservation process quick and easy:

- Top 3 preferred trip dates (In Preference Order)
- Arrival & Departure Time
- Number of homerooms/groups
- Attendance numbers of students and adults (separately)
- Grade level(s) of students
- If you want to upgrade your visit to include the traveling exhibit
- Lunch and gift shop plans
- Group Leader's name, phone number, and email address

#### **Payment Policy**

A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required upon confirmation of your reservation. The deposit must be received within 30 days of receipt but no later than three (3) weeks prior to the trip date. Purchase Orders will be accepted in advance only and will not be accepted on the day of your visit. Final Payment is required no later than two (2) weeks prior to the trip date. Payments will no longer be accepted the day of the trip. Payments must be made in a single transaction. Group participants may not pay separately.

#### **Rescheduling and Cancellation Policy**

Please call us immediately if you need to reschedule or cancel your group visit.

Rescheduling: 15+ days prior- one (1) free date change. Additional changes may result in a \$25 processing fee. 0-14 days prior- A \$25 processing fee may be applied. Cancellations: 15+ days prior: Full refund, minus \$100 non-refundable deposit. 0-14 days prior- No refund or reschedule to a new trip date within one (1) year.

#### Changes in Attendance Policy

If your group size changes after you make your reservation, please notify us as soon as possible, but no later than 5pm two(2) weeks prior to your trip date. No refunds will be given for lower attendance or unused group tickets within two(2) weeks of your trip date. Any additions to your group attendance are subject to availability and are not guaranteed access to programs. Any additions to your group attendance after final payment is due are required to paid via credit card over the phone in advance of your trip date. You must have or pay for a minimum of 15 paid tickets to constitute a reserved group visit.

#### Chaperone Policy

One (1) free adult for every ten (10) Students as we do require a 1:10 Chaperone to student ratio. Any chaperones not included in the group reservation must either pay regular general admission ticket rates at the front desk or pre-purchase tickets in advance online. A school nurse and required 1:1 paraprofessionals receive free admission.

#### Membership Policy

Da Vinci Science Center memberships are not valid for free group admission. Students and Adults must pay the group rate.

#### Dinos Alive (May 22-September 8, 2024)



#### Sharks (Coming this Fall)

Older than dinosaurs-and more threatened than threatening-sharks are spectacular, surprising, and often misunderstood. Discover the incredible diversity of this ancient and fascinating group of fishes. Explore an array of 12 casts of jaws and teeth of various shark species, from a great white shark's serrated teeth for hunting seals to a zebra shark's small, sharp teeth specialized to chew through shells.

## Savings and Scholarships

#### Linny Fowler STEAM Scholarship Fund

The Da Vinci Science Center provides need- and interest-based scholarships to students for Field Trips, Outreach Programs, Summer Camps, and other experiences.

Schools qualifying for Linny Fowler STEAM Scholarship Fund (formerly known as the Science Inquiry Fund) support serve student bodies in which at least 40 percent of its students qualify for free or reduced-price meals. Qualifying childcare centers serve student bodies in which more than 40 percent of children qualify for a Pennsylvania Child Care Works (CCW) subsidy.

Applications for Linny Fowler STEAM Scholarship Fund can be submitted at any time. Notifications are made on a rolling basis. Funds are available to qualified organizations and individuals only. Organizations will not be granted more than \$1,500 per year. Organizations may receive partial funding, based on funds available. School field trips supported by the STEAM Scholarship Fund must take place between September 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>. Summer groups may also visit from June 19<sup>th</sup> through August 31<sup>st</sup>. The Linny Fowler STEAM Scholarship Fund does not cover meals or transportation.
